A. **RCPGP** – As stated last month, an additional \$230,000 is being added to this grant for Regional Catastrophic Preparedness courses. An extension has been given and we now have until April 30, 2013. If you have any immediate needs, please contact me ASAP.

Julie Linney stated an additional \$230,000 has been added for RCPGP courses and recommended if the workgroup had any immediate needs to contact her. Julie also stated she has been working on the match for 2010 and there is additional money for match available and to please contact her if the workgroup is aware of any courses related to RCPGP that have not gone through UASI.

B. **2013 Project Proposals** – All 2013 Project Proposals will be reviewed at the next Advisory Group Meeting on February 28, 2013. At this time, all proposals will be reviewed for compliance with the Strategy and applicable UASI, CalEMA and FEMA



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guidance. They will also confirm prioritization of projects based on attainable mitigation of regional risk.

Julie Linney advised the workgroup the 2013 proposals have gone through the hub process and will be given to the Advisory Group next week to be reviewed for grant compliance and to confirm prioritization. The projects will then be given to the Approval Authority.

## III. REGIONAL TRAINING & EXERCISE PROGRAM - Dennis Houghtelling

## A. ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING NON-ATTENDACE/REGISTRATION BLOCKING

Commander Houghtelling informed the workgroup the website has been updated to automatically block user registration for six months based on the most recent course the user failed to attend. Commander Houghtelling also mentioned that an additional \$250,000 from 2011 salary savings will be added to the training budget with UASI approval and there may be additional salary savings with 2012 money.

#### B. TRAINING PROPOSAL VETTING

The Regional Training & Exercise Program staff conducted a vetting session with the workgroup for submitted course proposals. Commander Houghtelling also advised the workgroup that if a course gets approved as a result of the vetting process, the course can not be scheduled without first contacting the Regional Training & Exercise Program Planners. Kelly Seitz also advised the workgroup several of the proposals submitted were reviewed by the Regional Training & Exercise Program staff and were moved to the approved list based on prior vetting sessions and regional needs or where consistent with the Multi-Year Training & Exercise Plan.
